4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Home Secretary, Government of Tamil Nadu, is *suo motu* impleaded as a party in this writ petition.

Accordingly, the *suo motu* impleaded/third respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass orders on the same by taking into account the report submitted by the Probation Officer, Madurai, on merits and in accordance with law within seven days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
