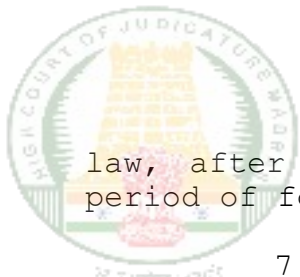
2. Mr.T.S.Md.Mohideen, the learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the 1st respondent.

3. By consent, this Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that it would be suffice, if the representation of the petitioner is disposed of, by the 1st respondents, on merits and in accordance with law within the time stipulated by this Court.

5. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation of the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law.

6. In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner in this Writ Petition, the 1st respondent is directed to consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 28.04.2015, on merits and in accordance with



law, after giving notice to the interested parties, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
