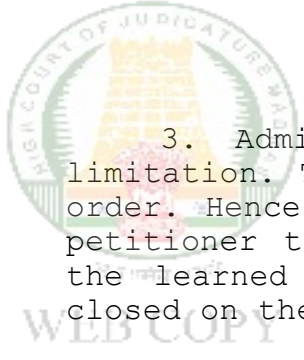

3. Admittedly, the complaint has been closed on the ground of limitation. Therefore, the petitioner will have to get a copy of the said order. Hence, this Writ Petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to file an application seeking a copy of the order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pudukottai, by whom the complaint was closed on the ground of limitation.

Further this court directs the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pudukottai, as and when an application made, appropriate copy of the order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pudukottai, will have to be given to the petitioner, within a period of two weeks. After receiving the same the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same in the manner known to law. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
