The petitioner seeks for a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to dispose of the disciplinary action initiated by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in his memo No.A2/6748/2011 dated 29.11.2011 by passing appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a stipulated time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

2. Mr.D.Muruganantham, Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents. By consent, the Writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

3.The case of the petitioner is that he is working as a Deputy Tahsildar in Sivagangai District. When the petitioner was working as a Zonal Deputy Tahsildar at Okkur Zone, Sivagangai Taluk, disciplinary action was initiated against him by issuing a memo No.A2/6748/2011, dated 29.11.2011.



charge memo on 30.12.2011. Thereafter, an Enquiry Officer has been appointed, who in turn has also conducted enquiry and submitted his enquiry report to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent / District Collector, Sivagangai on 18.06.2014. The grievance of the petitioner is that the disciplinary action initiated against him is still pending with the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and the petitioner is going to retire on 30.06.2016. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court with the present Writ petition for the above said relief.

3.Considering the limited prayer sought for by the petitioner, the first respondent is directed to pass orders on the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if there are no other legal impediment.

4.The Writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
