Therefore, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner in this Writ Petition, as and when the petitioner produces the necessary documents, the respondent shall consider the claim of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, after giving notice to the interested parties, if any, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
