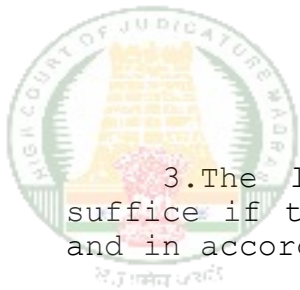

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner is disposed of, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, the second respondent is directed to consider the representations of the petitioner, dated 24.08.2011 and 28.05.2015 on merits and in accordance with law, in the light of the decision of this Court in W.P.(MD)No.6196 of 2011, dated 22.01.2014, and pass appropriate orders within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
