ORDER

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner in this Writ Petition, the second and the third respondents are directed to pass appropriate orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 15.06.2015, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
