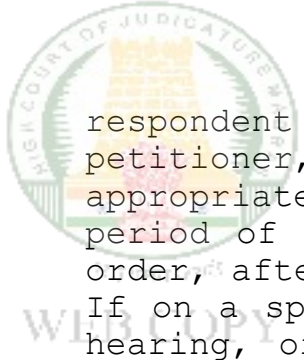
O R D E R

This Writ Petition has been filed, praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondent to promote the petitioner in the post of Inspector of Police retrospectively with effect from 01.09.2000 in accordance with the orders of the Commissioner of Police, Madurai City passed in his CPO.No.2118 of 2000, C.No.A2/36338/2000, dated 31.08.2000.

2.Mr.S.Kumar, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent and by consent of both parties, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

3.The learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner is disposed of, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the issue involved, the



respondent is directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner, dated 11.07.2015, if not already disposed of, and pass appropriate orders on the same and in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording the petitioner an opportunity of being heard. If on a specified date the petitioner does not appear for personal hearing, orders may be passed in accordance with law based on the available records after recording the absence of the Party/Parties. The persons, who are likely to be affected are also to be heard before any final decision is to be taken.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petitions is closed.
