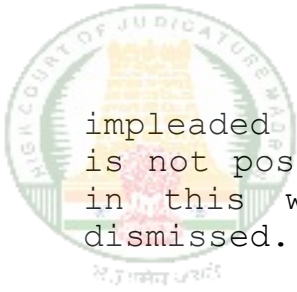
ORDER

2. We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Special Government Pleader for the respondents 1 to 3 and we have also perused the records carefully.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that 7 known persons have encroached upon the portion of Oorani and they have constructed small huts. But those 7 persons have not been



impleaded as a parties. Without affording opportunity to them, it is not possible for this Court to issue any direction as prayed for in this writ petition. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
