4.The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that it would suffice, if the representation of the petitioner is disposed of, on merits, and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

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5.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the respondents are directed to dispose of the petitioner's representation, dated 11.08.2015, and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order
