PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing to direct the 1st respondent to consider the representation dated 15.12.2014 and to give the notional weightage of 5 years to the petitioners qualifying service for the purpose of calculating pension and accordingly grant the revised pension retrospectively and to pay the consequential arrears arising there from with interest on the differential pension and to pay pension arrears and interest within the stipulated time fixed by this Honble Court.

ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed, praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 15.12.2014 and to give the notional weightage of 5 years to the petitioner's qualifying service for the purpose of calculating our pension and accordingly grant the revised pension retrospectively and to pay the consequential arrears arising there from with interest on the differential pension and to pay pension arrears and interest within a time stipulated by this Court.
