Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus to direct the first respondent to issue revised order, as done in G.O.(1D) No.415 revenue (services 7(1) department dated 25.08.2014 in petitioner case also, declaring that the petitioner have completed his probation retrospectively with effect from 06.08.1997 and consequently pay all yearly increment benefits and revised pension benefits.

Mr.D.Muruganantham, learned Additional Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondents.

2. By consent, the writ petition is taken up for disposal.

3. The petitioner seeks for a direction to the first respondent to issue revised order as done in G.O.(1D) No.415 revenue (services 7(1) department dated 25.08.2014 and to declare that he has completed the probation retrospectively with effect from 06.08.1997.

4. In fact, it is seen that the petitioner seeks completion of his probation retrospectively and such request is being made after his retirement.

5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that in similarly situated matters, the first respondent has granted the order of retrospective probation.
