2. We have full faith on the District Collector to consider the objections raised by the persons concerned in the matter of location of TASMAC shops. The representation, based on which the complaint is made, may be considered by the District Collector and if any violation is found, the shop may be directed to be relocated in an appropriate place.



3. With the above observation, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
