Such exercise shall be done by the first respondent within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

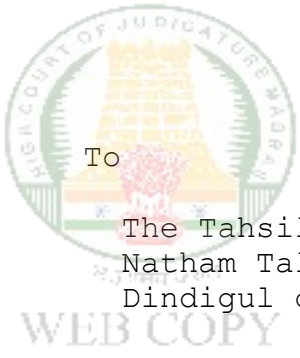
3.The writ petition is disposed accordingly. No costs.
