He submitted that as against the rejection of a request for the grant of community certificate, a remedy of appeal is now provided under G.O.Ms.No.235, Revenue Department, dated 26.06.2015 to the District Collector.

period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Thereafter, the District Collector, shall hold an enquiry and give opportunity to the petitioner to produce relevant documents and pass appropriate orders within a further period of eight weeks. Registry shall return the original impugned order to the petitioner to enable him to file appeal. No costs. Consequently, M.P(MD)No.1 of 2015 is closed.
