The petitioner seeks for a Writ of Mandamus to direct the fifth respondent to survey the petitioner's lands in Survey Nos.589/1, 589/3A5A, 589/3C, 589/3B1, 589/1A, 589/4, 589/3B1 and 589/3C1 and direct the fifth respondent to ear-mark the actual acquisition by erecting boundary stone and to file a report before the Court.
