Mr.R.Anandaraj, learned Government Advocate takes notice for the respondents 1 & 2 in all the Writ Petitions.

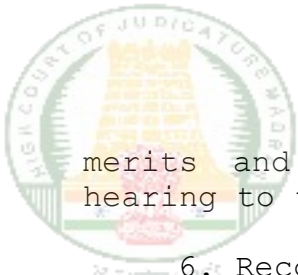
2. By consent of parties, the main Writ Petitions are taken up for final disposal.

4. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respective third respondent is violating the route permit and operating the mini-bus.
