It is stated that the petitioner's husband he worked for 42 years and therefore the petitioner is entitled to get the Family Pension. Claiming so, she made a representation on 11.02.2015 and the same is still pending. Hence, the petitioner is before this court.

Considering the above said facts and circumstances, the first respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 11.02.2015 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
