3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the petitioner is not prevented from reaching home during festival time.

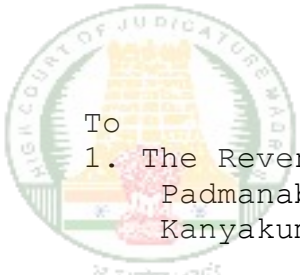
