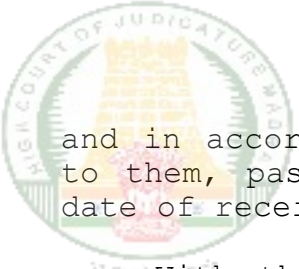

The petitioners have come forward with these writ petitions, seeking for a direction to the respondent to consider and pass orders on the their representation dated 17.10.2014 made in regard to extend the benefits granted in G.O.Ms.No.100, School Education Department dated 13.04.2010 to the petitioners.

2. The case of the petitioners is that pursuant to the liberty granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP (CC) No.14300-14303 of 2014, they made a representation to the respondent on 17.10.2014 to extend the benefit of G.O.Ms.No.100, School Education Department dated 13.04.2014, as the same was given to similarly placed persons.
