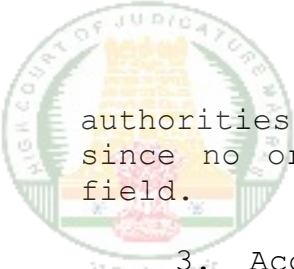

COMMON ORDER

The writ petitions have been filed for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pass a revision order for the assessment year 2011-12 and 2012-13 respectively, by giving effect to the order passed by the Appellate Deputy Commissioner (CT), Madurai (South) in VAT AP Nos. 72 & 73/2014, respectively dated 28.11.2014.

2. In view of the order passed in the appeal by the Appellate Authority, viz., the Appellate Deputy Commissioner (CT), Madurai (South) in Appeal Nos. 72 & 73/2014, respectively, as early as on 28.11.2014, the petitioner now only seeks for a consequential order being passed by the



authorities concerned. In spite of his representations, dated 03.02.2015, since no orders have been passed, the present writ petitions have been field.
