ORDER

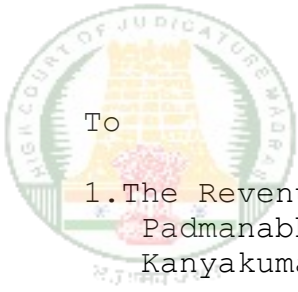

It was followed by reminder dated 25.02.2015. As no orders are passed on the same, the present writ petition has been filed.

2.Taking note of the above said facts particularly pendency of the complaint and the reminder, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 15.10.2014 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as to the private respondents.
