Kalaiselvan, who died on 23.11.2013 while in service with respondents 1 and 2.

The Writ petition has been filed seeking to issue Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 28.01.2015 and sanction all death benefits viz., pension and other benefits in view of death of my husband viz., M.
