PRAYER: The Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the impugned order, dated 29.03.2015 passed by the second respondent and quash the same and directing the respondents to grant permission and necessary protection to perform cultural programme (i.e) Dance Programme on 12.04.2015 at 06.00 p.m., to 10.30 p.m. in the festival of Arulmighu Sree Kaliyamman Kovil at T.Meenatchipuram, Gandamanur, Andipatti Taluk, Theni District.

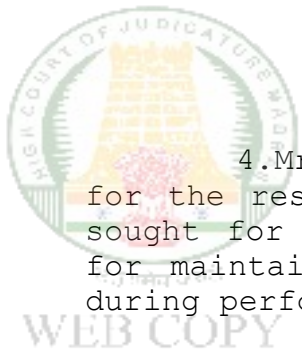
O R D E R

(Order of this Court was made by S.TAMILVANAN,J.)

This Writ petition has been filed invoking Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking an order in the nature of Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to quash the impugned order, dated 29.03.2015 passed by the second respondent and to direct the respondents to grant permission and necessary protection to perform cultural programme (i.e) Dance Programme on 12.04.2015 at 06.00 p.m., to 10.30 p.m. in the festival of Arulmighu Sree Kaliyamman Kovil at T.Meenatchipuram, Gandamanur, Andipatti Taluk, Theni District.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3.Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that 'cultural dance programme' is being conducted by the villagers during the above said festival period. In this connection, a representation was given to the second respondent, however, the same was rejected by the second respondent and hence, the petitioner is before this Court with this Writ petition. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submitted that as the aforesaid festival is celebrated in a service of the village, the villagers, there will be no untoward incident by the people of the village.



4.Mr.M.Alagathevan, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, on instructions, would submit that the permission sought for by the petitioner may be granted with stringent conditions for maintaining law and order and also to avoid any untoward incident during performance of such programme.

5.Having considered the facts and circumstances and the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, we are of the view that necessary permission shall be granted to the petitioner and his villagers to conduct 'cultural dance programme' in the aforesaid Temple with reasonable conditions.

6.Accordingly, the impugned order of the second respondent dated 29.03.2015, is set aside and the Writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:

(a)The 'cultural dance programme'in connection with the festival of Arulmighu Sree Kalliamman Kovil at T.Meenatchipuram, Gandamanur, Andipatti Taluk, Theni District is to be held on 12.04.2015 between 6.00 p.m. and 10.30 p.m.

(b)There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogues during the performance, by anyone of the participants;

(c)Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and the youth.

(d)No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion community or caste be played.

(e)No flex boards in support of any political party or religious leader be erected.

(f)The function should not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(g)If there is any violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned police officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance; and

(h)Similarly, the police is empowered to stop the dance programme, if it exceeds beyond the permitted time.

(i)The second respondent is directed to issue necessary permission, incorporating the above conditions.
