ORDER

Considering the submission made by the learned Counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, a direction is given to the respondents to consider and pass appropriate order on the pending representation of the petitioner, dated 13.02.2015, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
