4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner is disposed of, by the official respondents, on merits and in accordance with law within the time stipulated by this Court.

5. The learned Government Advocates appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 would submit that the representation of the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner in this Writ Petition, the second respondent is directed to pass appropriate orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 13.05.2015, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving notice to the fourth respondent, and pass appropriate orders, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
