



4.It is averred in the petition that the petitioner is having shop No.124 situated in survey No.545/1 measuring to an extent of 1960 sq. ft. at South Street, Thiruvaiyaru, Thanjavur District. The said property was purchased by the father of the petitioner. From the date of purchase, he was in possession and enjoyment of the same. After his demise, the petitioner is in possession and enjoyment of the above said property. While so, the petitioner had applied for issuance of patta before the respondents along with all the relevant documents. He had also made representation to the respondents on 26.02.2015. But there was no response. Hence, the petitioner has come forward with the present Writ Petition for the above stated relief.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the averments made in the Writ Petition, this Court directs the petitioner to give a copy of the representation, dated 26.02.2015, to the third respondent, along with a copy of this order, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of the same, the third respondent is directed to consider the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as to all the necessary parties, with regard to issuance of patta, within a period of six weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No Costs.
