ORDER

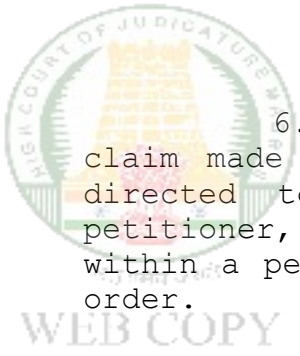
The petitioner has come forward with this Writ Petition praying for a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent herein to grant patta to the petitioner for his house site measuring 2850 sq.ft. comprised in old S. No. 68/1 and New S.
