This writ petition has been filed seeking for the issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to issue suitable order to the second respondent to give adequate police protection to the petitioner for enjoying his land comprised in Patta No.759 and 1948 in Keelakudalur Village in Uthamapalayam Taluk in Theni District as per the order of this Court made in C.R.P.No.259/2014, date 01.08.2014 by disposing his representation dated 05.02.2015.
