This court is not willing to go into the allegations as well as the denial. As the representation of the petitioner dated 12.08.2013 is yet to be disposed of, without going into the merits, the third respondent is directed to pass an appropriate order in accordance with law, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No Costs.
