2. None appears for the petitioner.

3.The respondents have filed a detailed counter, wherein at paragraphs - 6 to 9 it is clearly stated about the measures which have already taken and what measures cannot be taken. It is also stated that there is no justification to stop express trains in the said railway station, since it is located very close to Tiruchirappalli Junction.



4. We do not find any reason to issue further direction in public interest, since the authorities concerned have already taken possible steps. Hence, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs.
