VENKATESH GUPTA, presented this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the Affidavit filed here in the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 3rd Respondent in proceeding with E.A.No. 16 of 2015 in C.C.No. 235 of 2011 in spite of the appeal in F.A.No. 64 of 2015 is filed and pending for hearing and disposal on the file of the 2nd Respondent, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and contrary to the provisions contained under S.24 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 and has the effect of violation of the fundamental rights guaranteed to the petitioners u/a 14 and 2 of the Constitution of India and consequently stay all the further proceedings in E.A.No. 16 of 2015 till the appeal in FA No. 64 of 2015 is disposed by the 2nd Respondent;
