ORDER:

It appears from the pleadings that the applicant has already nominated its choice of arbitrator. However, the respondents have not done so.

Under these circumstances, I direct the respondents to exercise their choice of nominee arbitrator within fortnight from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, Sri D. Singarachary, a retired District Judge residing at Hyderabad shall be appointed as nominee arbitrator of the respondents. Thereafter, both the learned arbitrators shall nominate the third arbitrator in terms of the arbitration agreement.

The remuneration of the respective nominee Arbitrators of the respective parties shall be borne by the respective parties individually.

However, so far as the third Arbitrator is concerned, the learned Arbitrator shall fix his own remuneration upon deliberation and consultation with the parties. He shall also estimate the cost and expenses of the secretarial assistance and other incidental expenditure for the arbitration proceedings. The parties shall bear the expenses of the arbitration proceedings in equal share. The learned Arbitrators are directed to complete the arbitration proceedings by making and publishing an award within a period of five months from the date of entering upon the reference.

The arbitration application is accordingly disposed of.
