JUDGMENT: {Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

Sri B.Narasimha Sarma, learned Standing Counsel for Income Tax Department, while fairly stating that the question which arises for consideration in this appeal is covered against the Revenue by a Division Bench judgment of this Court in **CIT v. My Home Power Ltd.**, would however contend that the Department had preferred an appeal to the Supreme Court against the order of the Division Bench in **My Home Power Ltd.**¹.

The mere fact that the matter is pending before the Supreme Court, would not justify a different view being taken from that of the earlier Division Bench. It is not even contended before us that the order of the Division Bench in **My Home Power Ltd.**¹ has been set aside by the Supreme Court. We see no reason, therefore, to entertain this appeal.

Following the judgment of the Division Bench in **My Home Power Ltd.**¹, this appeal is also dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand dismissed.
