

HONOURABLE Dr. JUSTICE B.SIVA SANKARA RAO

CRIMINAL PETITION No.3251 of 2015

ORDER :

The Petition is filed by the Petitioners/A.1 and A.2 under Section 482 Cr.P.C to quash the proceedings in Crime No.151/2010 of Humayunnagar, Hyderabad, registered at the instance of the 1st respondent for offence punishable under Sections 324 read with 34 I.P.C.

2) The Petitioners/A.1 and A.2 and the 2nd respondent/defacto-complainant filed a petition in CrI.P.M.P.No.3447 of 2015 praying to permit the parties to compromise the matter and another petition in CrI.P.M.P. No.3446 of 2015 praying to quash the proceedings in view of their compromise.

3) Both the parties present before the Court. Heard and perused the material on record. The defacto-complainant stated that the compounding is to purchase peace.

4) No doubt, as per Section 320 of Cr.P.C., the offence under Section 324 IPC is not compoundable though the offence under Section 325 IPC is compoundable. This Court by order in CrI.R.C.No.1885 of 2014 dated 12.09.2014 observed that the offence under Section 324 IPC is compoundable and there is a mistake in the mention of the schedule as if non-compoundable having been noted as compoundable the aggravated form to the grievous hurt is not voluntary under Section 325 Cr.P.C.

5) Accordingly, permission is accorded to the petitioners/A.1 and A.2 to compound the offence with the 1st respondent in the above crime to subserve the ends of justice and in terms of their compromise.

6) Accordingly, the petition is allowed and all the proceedings relating to Crime No.151 of 2010 of Humayunnagar, Hyderabad are

quashed. The bail bonds of the petitioners, if any, shall stand cancelled.

7) Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, in this Criminal Petition shall stand closed.
