The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for a *Mandamus* to declare the action of the respondents in suspending the petitioner from the college without holding any enquiry as illegal and arbitrary.

At the hearing, Sri M.Karthik Pavan Kumar, the

learned counsel representing Sri C.Suman, the learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that during the pendency of this Writ Petition, the petitioner has left the institution and that therefore, the cause in the Writ Petition does not survive for adjudication.
