The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The petitioner, who is working as Anganwadi Helper at II Town Police Station-2 Anganwadi Centre, Kummarikunta, YSR Kadapa Urban, filed this Writ Petition feeling aggrieved by the action of respondent No.3 in not receiving her application for being promoted as Anganwadi Worker in one of the 27 vacancies of the post of Anganwadi Workers notified for Kadapa Urban.

In support of her plea that she is entitled for such consideration, she has placed reliance on Memo No.5771/K3/2006, dated 03.12.2010, wherein the Director of Women Development & Child Welfare, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad, directed all the Project Directors to fill up the vacancies of Anganwadi Workers with eligible Anganwadi Helpers. The petitioner further pleaded that her application for promotion as Anganwadi Worker is not being received by the respondents.

In the light of the above facts, respondent No.3 is directed to consider the petitioner's case for promotion as Anganwadi Worker in terms of Memo No.5771/K3/2006, dated 03.12.2010, in one of the 27 Anganwadi Centres in Kadapa Urban notified on 06.10.2015.

Subject to the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.

As a sequel to disposal of the Writ Petition, WPMP.No.45680 of 2015 filed by the petitioner for interim relief is disposed of as infructuous.
