**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed for a *Mandamus* to declare the inaction on the part of respondent Nos.3 to 7 in implementing proceedings No.DT/35164/2013, dated 23.11.2013, of respondent No.2 as illegal and arbitrary.
