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**ORDER:**

The grievance of the petitioner is that the Revenue Authorities are not issuing a pattadar pass book and title deed to her, though she has applied in the prescribed

format.

The material filed along with the writ petition shows that the petitioner did apply by way of an application in Form-VI(A) as prescribed under the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Rights in Land and Pattadar Passbooks Act, 1971. That being so, it is for the Tahsildar, Rapthadu Mandal, Anantapur District, to consider the same in accordance with law, cause enquiry as per due procedure and thereafter take action.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue states that this process would take some amount of time and a direction may be issued accordingly.

The writ petition is therefore disposed of directing the Tahsildar, Rapthadu Mandal, Anantapur District, to consider the petitioner's Form-VI(A) application dated 01.12.2014 and take appropriate action thereon in accordance with law within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Pending Miscellaneous Petitions shall stand closed in the light of this final order. No order as to costs.
