

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE R. KANTHA RAO**

**W.P.No.6322 of 2015**

**ORDER:**

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Civil Supplies appearing for respondents 1 to 4.

This Writ Petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in suspending the authorization of the petitioner *vide* order dated 13.02.2015, as arbitrary and illegal.

The petitioner is the dealer of fair price shop No.29, Gorukallu Village, Panyam Mandal, Kurnool District. On 05.01.2015, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent along with Mandal Revenue Inspector and Village Revenue Officer, inspected the fair price shop of the petitioner and found certain variations in the stocks. Based on the report submitted by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent *vide* order dated 13.2.2015 suspended the authorization of the petitioner. Aggrieved thereby, the petitioner preferred an appeal along with stay application before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent on 28.2.2015 and the same is pending.

Since the authorization of the petitioner was suspended on specific allegations, I am not inclined to

go into the merits of the case.

Under these circumstances, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is directed to conduct enquiry and pass final order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, notwithstanding the pendency of the appeal before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent-Joint Collector, Kurnool.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
