COMMON JUDGMENT:

Both the parties are present and they are identified by their respective counsel. The contents of the memorandum of compromise are read over to the parties and they admitted that they voluntarily entered into the compromise.

In view of the compromise arrived between the parties, I find that it is a fit case to record the compromise by exercising power under Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure. Accordingly, the petition is ordered.
