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COMMON ORDER:

One M.H.S.Babu is the petitioner in these writ petitions.

At the time of hearing, it is brought to the notice of the Court that M.H.S.Babu/petitioner died on 07.08.2014 and his wife Smt.M.Swarna Lalitha through an affidavit and through a separate letter has requested the learned counsel representing Sri M.H.S. Babu to withdraw the writ petitions.

I am not getting into the procedural aspect of such a request at the stage of the matter. Suffice to note that M.H.S.Babu died on 07.08.2014 and his wife does not want to prosecute the writ petitions.
