ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for a *mandamus* to declare notice of sale, dated 29.12.2011, of respondent No.1 as illegal and arbitrary.

At the hearing, Ms.Suruchi Singh, learned counsel representing Mr.Sarang Afzulpurkar, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that the cause in the writ petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above submission, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, interim order, dated 14.02.2012 is vacated and W.P.M.P.No.4845 of 2012 and W.V.M.P.No.3921 of 2014 shall stand dismissed as infructuous.
