and 2 and Smt.G.Sampada, learned counsel for 3rd respondent.

2. The grievance of the petitioner in this Revision Petition is that I.A.No.69 of 2014 filed by her in O.S.No.21 of 2005 to pass a final decree in the above suit for partition be decided expeditiously in view of the fact that the petitioner is aged about 84 years.
