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COMMON ORDER:

CRPMP No.2589 of 2015 is filed to set aside the default order dated 18.2.2015 in CRP No.2073 of 2003. The learned counsel for both the parties submitted that the petition may be allowed. The submission is accepted. Accordingly, the CRPMP is allowed, setting aside the default order dated 18.2.2015 and the CRP is restored to file.
