Writ Petition No.5471 of 2015

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Civil Supplies.

2. This writ petition is filed seeking writ of *Mandamus* declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in issuing proceedings dated 12.02.2015 suspending the authorisation of the petitioner's Fair Price shop No.7 of A.Narayanapuram Village, Anantapuram Rural Mandal, Ananthapuram District, , as illegal and arbitrary.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the suspension order was passed behind back of the petitioner on trivial charges and therefore, he seeks to revoke the suspension order. The suspension order was passed on 12.02.2015. So far no enquiry was initiated against the petitioner for the purpose of passing final orders. Learned Government Pleader for Civil supplies submits that there are as many as 10 charges framed against the petitioner and the order being one of the suspension pending enquiry, need not be interfered with.

4. Considering the submissions made by both sides and following the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court passed in WP MP No.343 of 2015 in WA No.118 of 2015, this writ petition is disposed of directing the 3rd respondent to conduct enquiry against the petitioner and pass final orders within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.
