**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a Writ of Mandamus, to set aside the Memo No.6882/UE.II/2010-I, dated 06.07.2010 issued by the 2nd respondent declaring the same as illegal, arbitrary and against the guidelines of UGC and consequently declare that the petitioners are entitled to the pay band of Rs.37400-67000 with AGP Rs.9,000/- by directing the

respondents to pay the same to the petitioners from the date of their appointment and joining.

2. It is agreed by both the learned counsel appearing for the parties that the issue raised in this writ petition is squarely covered by order dated 23.06.2014 passed by this Court in W.P.Nos.18255, 18256, 20544, 21883, 21894 and 25907 of 2010.

3. In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed of in terms of the said order with the direction that the observations made therein shall be read as part of this order. In the circumstances, there shall be no order as to costs. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
