Criminal Petition No.4240 of 2015

ORDER:

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The criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.480 of 2015 on the file of XXV Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad arising out of Crime No.174 of 2014 on the file of Gachibowli Police Station, Cyberabad for the offences punishable under Sections 498 A and 323 IPC.

The 2nd respondent/*de facto* complainant and her counsel are present. The petitioners/accused and their counsel are also present.

Heard both sides and perused the record.

On the report of the 2nd respondent/*de facto* complainant, the Station House Officer, Gachibowli Police Station, Cyberabad registered a case in Cr.No.174 of 2014 against the petitioner/accused for the offence alleged, and after completion of

investigation, filed the charge sheet.

It is submitted by both parties that at the intervention of the elders, the parties have amicably settled their disputes concerning to present case and hence compromise may be recorded and criminal proceedings in the above case may be quashed.

Having regard to the above submission and considering the fact that the parties have amicably settled the disputes among themselves out of Court and no useful purpose will be served even if the parties are driven to the trial as they compromised, and following the decision reported in ***Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another***^[1] the criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and compromise is recorded, and consequently, the proceedings in C.C.No.480 of 2015 on the file of XXV Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad arising out of Crime No.174 of 2014 on the file of Gachibowli Police Station, Cyberabad against the petitioner/Accused are hereby quashed.

The CrI.P.MP.No.10617 of 2015 and CrI.P.No.4240 of 2015 are accordingly allowed.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
