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ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for a *mandamus* to declare the action of the respondents in not considering the cases of the petitioners for appointment as the fair price shop dealers by way of conversion from kerosene dealers in terms of G.O.Ms.No.52, dated 18.12.2008, as illegal and arbitrary.

At the hearing, Mr.M.Yeshwanth Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, has submitted that the cause in the writ petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above submission, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, W.P.M.P.No.15011 of 2011 filed by the petitioners for interim relief shall stand dismissed as infructuous.
