

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE T.SUNIL CHOWDARY

CRIMINAL PETITION No.3050 of 2015

ORDER:

This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.1234 of 2014 on the file of the X Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad.

The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to permit the petitioners to withdraw the criminal petition with liberty to avail the remedies available to them under law including filing of the discharge petition, if charges are already not framed.

Permission is granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the presence of petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4 may be dispensed with before the trial Court on each and every date of adjournment.

There is no dispute with regard to the identity of petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4 in view of *inter se* relation between them. Even if the presence of petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4 is dispensed with, no prejudice will be caused to the second respondent.

Hence, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The presence of petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4, who are accused Nos.1, 3 and 4 in C.C.No.1234 of 2014 on the file of the X Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad, is hereby dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. However, they shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required.

Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
